2017 EXHIBIT SPACE RESTRICTIONS

The exhibit space restrictions in effect for 2017 are based on a sound business decision to maintain the integrity of the OTC priority system as well as to benefit all OTC exhibitors. In summary, OTC 2017 will operate under a “no growth” policy inside the NRG Center; therefore exhibit space in NRG Center will be determined using the exhibitor’s 2015 and 2016 indoor space utilization.

Exhibit Space Restrictions

- Exhibitors with a priority number will be allowed to contract indoor exhibit space equivalent to their 2015 or 2016 indoor exhibit space, whichever is greater. The following are two scenarios:
 - In 2015, Exhibitor A had 400 indoor net square feet, and in 2016, Exhibitor A had 200 indoor net square feet. In 2017, Exhibitor A will be allowed to contract for 400 indoor net square feet.
 - In 2015, Exhibitor B had 1,000 indoor net square feet, and in 2016, Exhibitor B had 1,000 indoor net square feet. In 2017, Exhibitor B will be allowed to contract for 1,000 indoor net square feet.
 - Exception: An exhibitor who had 100 square feet indoor space in 2015 and 100 square feet indoor space in 2016 may increase to 200 square feet indoor space in 2017.

Indoor space in NRG Arena is not subject to space restrictions. Any increase in space in NRG Arena, over an exhibitor’s previous space allotment, will not be useable if moved into NRG Center.

- The maximum allowable exhibit space for an international pavilion (pavilion/organizer) or one company (including divisions and subsidiaries) may not exceed 10,000 indoor net square feet of which all square feet must be contiguous. This will be uniformly enforced.
- An exhibitor requesting a separate location(s) for its division(s) will only be allowed to contract for space per the restricted net square footage. All exhibit space must be contiguous.
- A new exhibiting company, with no priority number, will only be allowed to contract for a total of 200 indoor net square feet, unless they are located in the NRG Arena.
- There are currently no space restrictions for the outdoor exhibition areas, whether the exhibitor has a priority number or is a new exhibiting company; however, outdoor space will not be used in calculating your maximum allotted indoor space.
- The OTC Pavilion is considered to be outdoor space and will not be used in calculating your maximum allotted indoor space.
- International Pavilions are restricted to the country pavilion’s 2015 or 2016 OTC Pavilion exhibit space, whichever is greater.
- In order to maintain the integrity of the OTC Space Assignment Process, these restrictions will be uniformly enforced to all exhibitors with no exceptions permitted.
